Type of Work: Hydrographic Survey in Support of Offshore Wind

Waterway and location where work will be done: Nearshore waters off Sandbridge, Virginia Beach, Virginia, and within the vicinity of Rudee Inlet.

Latitude & Longitude of work area (Degrees, Minutes, Thousandths of seconds): Northwest corner: 36° 45' 6" N 75° 56' 42" W
Southeast corner: 36° 43' 51" N 75° 55' 53" W

Work Start & Stop dates and Hours of Operation: Survey operations begin May 12, 2021 and are expected to end on May 28, 2021. Survey operations will begin around Sandbridge from 15 m depths and inshore. Surveys will be conducted from dawn to dusk.

Equipment on scene: The RV 4Points is a 25 ft fiberglass cabin survey vessel operating multibeam sonar, sub-bottom profiler, and towed magnetometer.

Passing Arrangements / Time to move vessels to not impede navigation: Limited maneuverability during survey and tow operations request a ½ nautical mile distance when possible. Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed in the vicinity of the survey vessels to minimize wake and keep clear of the stern of the vessel.

VHF Radio Channel monitored: All survey vessels have AIS and will monitor VHF channels 16/13
